#### **FOREWORD**

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya is a rural college established in 1996 and is associated with the name of Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta, the younger brother of the Vedantic Scientist Swami Vivekananda and a pioneering personality of the glorious Bengal Renaissance. Dr. Dutta's involvement with Hatgobindapur and its surrounding areas went back to preindependence days when he was involved to bring about the much-awaited socio-economic development of this rural area. To commemorate his work and contribution, a decision had been taken in a mass meeting in 1983 to establish a general degree college in the name of Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta and thereafter Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya was established in 1996, as a State Govt. Aided College affiliated to The University of Burdwan.

#### Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta:

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta, the younger brother of Warrior Monk Swami Vivekananda was born in Kolkata (Calcutta) in September, 4, 1880. Bhupendra Nath was a noted revolutionary, political thinker, sociologist and foremost figure among the Indian intellectuals. He was associated with Rishi Aurobindo and the Jugantar Group of revolutionaries. Bhupendra Nath Dutta joined the All India Revolutionary Society and his revolutionary consciousness was expressed in his writings in the weekly Jugantar and Sonar Bangla for which the British authorities jailed him. At the end of his imprisonment he sailed to America and after graduating from the New York University in 1912, he earned a Masters' Degree from the Brown University in 1914. When he visited Southern Europe in 1915, he came across other Indian revolutionaries and was elected as the Secretary of the Berlin Committee for the period of 1916-1918. Simultaneously, with his revolutionary activities, he carried out academic research in Sociology and Anthropology that earned him his doctorate degree from Hamburg University in 1923. This immensely gifted revolutionary scholar authored a number of books that included among others Indian Social System (3 volumes), "Dialecties of Hindu Ritualism" and "Agony of the Age". He was regarded as the most illustrious figure of the Bengal Renaissance and a dedicated nationalist. A firm believer in socialism, he had propounded the theory of the emergence of feudalism in the Indian context of the early medieval period. He had worked extensively on the nature of land holding in India and particularly was passionate about the land economy of Bengal that found reflection in his celebrated work entitled, "Dialectics of Land-Economics of India." Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta was involved in championing the cause of farmers and agricultural workers. One of the Presidents of Bengal Provincial Kisan Sabha, he was elected President twice of All India Trade Union Congress. Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta dedicated his life for the cause of socio-economic advancement of the rural poor and the under-privileged. He passed away at the age of 81, on December 25, 1961.

#### **VISION AND MISSION OF THE COLLEGE**

- (e) To give assistance to SC, ST and OBC and poor students to continue their higher studies
- (f) To uplift the rural poor through the non-formal vocational courses of education

#### Location & Communication

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya is situated at Hatgobindapur proper in an ambient pollution free environment, which is 12 kilometers away from Burdwan township, and 14 kms from Burdwan Railway Station, linked by Burdwan-Kalna road. It has good road connectivity and Saktigarh, the nearest Railway Station is only 6 kms. away from the college. All sorts of agricultural marketing and shopping facilities are available at the place and Hatgobindapur is famous for its 'Hat' on Monday and Thursday of every week. Frequent local bus services, long route bus services linking the South and North Bengal districts and Sub Divisional Head Quarters are also available with an important stoppage at this point.

- Admission in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of 4-year/3-year undergraduate (UG) Hons./Degree programs (under CCFUP as per NEP 2020) for the academic session 2023-24 will be online in standalone mode and strictly on the basis of merit, that is, performance at 10+2/Equivalent level public examination(s) as determined by The University of Burdwan (Notification no. R-C/UG-Perm/Adm/2 and HED Notification no. 354-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14).
- Candidates who have passed 10+2/Equivalent level examination from any recognized Council/Board/University (vide list of recognized Board/Council/University) in the year 2020/2021/2022/2023 can apply for admission in UG SEMESTER 1.
- 3. Students admitted in any UG Semester I course in 2022-23, who after University Registration did not fill up form for Semester 1 Examination, can get admission afresh (new) in 2023-24 within available intake capacity, retaining their old registration. They only have to fill up enrolment form and upload self-declaration in Online Portal.
- 4. Reservation rules are as per G.O. and extant rules of Govt. of W.B.
- 5. Reservation for Sports quota as per university guideline (Part B: Clause 8 of B.U. Notification no. R-C/UG-Perm/Adm/2 dated 16/06/23). Outstanding Sports Person with International/National/State/District level participation certificate in sports can apply for admission to 3 Yrs. Degree Course, if they have passed 10+2 level in aggregate. Category wise Admission in Sports quota will be on the basis merit of applicants.
- 6. Admission of candidates from and vocational stream will be guided by provision of Clauses 6.5-6.8 (Part A) and 6.2-6.5 & 7 (Part B) of B.U. Notification no. R-C/UG-Perm/Adm/2dated 16/06/2023.
- 7. In case of tie (equal Merit Point), the tie will be broken by taking into account the marks of 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> best scored subject of the candidate at 10+2/equivalent level (as perclause 12 of Part A and 14 of Part B of Notification no. R-C/UG-Perm/Adm/2 dated 16/06/23). In absence of affiliation and faculty, Hindi cannot be taken as major/minor subject

# **Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes as per NEP 2020**

Undergraduate Degree Programmes of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications such as

- a UG Certificate after completing 1 year (2 Semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study, provided that a skill based vocational course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 40 credits. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.
- a UG Diploma after 2 years (4 Semesters) of study, provided that a skill based vocational

course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 83 credits. These students are allowed to reenter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.

- a Bachelor's Degree after a 3-year (6 Semesters) programme of study,
- a Bachelor's Degree (Honours) after a 4-year (8 Semesters) programme of study. If the students complete a rigorous research project/ dissertation in their major area(s) of study inthe 4th year of a bachelor's degree then (Honours with Research).

#### **Major and Minor disciplines:**

- Major discipline is the discipline or subject of main focus and the degree will be awarded in that discipline. Students should secure the prescribed number of credits (about 50% of total credits) through core courses in the major discipline.
- Minor discipline helps a student to gain a broader understanding beyond the
  major discipline. For example, if a student pursuing an Economics major obtains a
  minimum of 12 credits from a bunch of courses in Statistics, then the student will
  beawarded B.A. degree in Economics with a Minor in Statistics.

#### 3-year UG Degree:

Students who wish to undergo a 3-year UG programme will be awarded UG Degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing 120 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirement.

#### 4-year UG Degree (Honours):

A four-year UG Honours degree in the major discipline will be awarded to those whocomplete a four-year degree programme with 160 credits and have satisfied the credit requirements.

#### 4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research):

Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research project or dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College. The research project/dissertation will bein the major discipline. The students who secure 160 credits, including 12 credits from a research project/dissertation, are awarded UG Degree (Honours with Research).
